Beers & ciders

Weihenstephen Heffe Weiss – Germany (500ml) 5.4% 3.60

This Bavarian brewery is the world's oldest continuously operating brewery, having produced beer since 1040 AD. A medium bodied palate with bubble gum, banana, clove, citrus and some spice.

Weihenstephen Kristall – Germany (500ml) 5.4% 3.60

A pale clear Bavarian wheat beer with a nose and body similar to, but lighter than, the Heffe Weiss. A perfect accompaniment to fish dishes.

Jever Pilsner – Germany (500ml) 4.9% 3.60

A world classic extra dry pilsner from the Friesland area of north Germany. Very bitter hop flavour and Martin Cooper's all-time favourite.

Erdinger Dunkel – Germany (500ml) 5.6% 3.60

Dark in colour the flavour is distinctive with a hint of chocolate. It goes well with salads, delicate fish dishes, pork, ham and egg dishes.

Chimay Rouge – Belgium (330ml) 7% 3.85

Lightly fruity and medium bodied with a restrained bitterness and a malty, blackcurrant aroma. Great with dark meat stews and gamey sausages

Duvel – Belgium (330ml) 8.5% 3.85

A strong golden ale with a subtle fruitiness and distinctive delicate taste that complements pasta and strong dishes made with lots of garlic.

De Konnick - Belgium (330ml) 5.5% 3.25

Brewed in Antwerp this pale beer is dangerously easy to drink, light with a malty finish and served in a bolleke style glass. This would be great paired with a pastrami on rye.

Delirium Tremens – Belgium (330ml) 8.5% 3.95

A strong complex blonde ale with slightly sweet malt on the tongue and a complex, dry and aromatic hop finish. A great aperitif beer.

Peroni Nastro Azzuro – Italy (330ml) 5.1% 3.00
Intensely crisp, lightly sparkling lager with a refreshing clean cut.

Innis and Gunn – Edinburgh (330ml) 6.6% 3.25
Matured in oak barrels previously used to mature bourbon for 77 days, this smooth honey hued beer takes on flavours of vanilla and toffee. One of Tom's favorites.

Brew Dog "Trashy Blonde" – Scotland (330ml) 4.1% 3.35
This craft beer brewery specializes in ales with a contemporary spin. Trashy blonde uses hops imported from America for a bitter, fruity but refreshing drink.

Kirin Ichiban – Japan (330ml) 5% 3.35
This eastern beer uses the purest and most expensive brewing method to create a pure, crisp and intensely satisfying taste that compliments all dishes on our menu.

Corona – Mexico (330ml) 4.6% 2.80
This crisp light beer complements most dishes with its unique balance of hop bitterness and sweet corn flavours. Good with spiced food.

Modelo Especial – Mexico (330ml) 5% 3.05
A premium quality, light lager with a slightly richer taste than similar beers. Its smooth and palatable nature means it tastes great with most foods.

Sagres – Portugal (330ml) 5% 2.80
Pale golden beer with a very fruity, flavoursome character that goes well with pasta, fish, white meats and salads.

Budvar – Czech Republic (330ml) 5% 3.60
This pale golden beer gives an aroma of toasted malt with a dash of vanilla and aromatic hops.

Shipwreck IPA – Liverpool (500ml) 6.5% **3.85**

IPAs were traditionally brewed strong and bitter as hops and alcohol are preservatives, this helped the beer survive long sea journeys to India. Liverpool Organic have tried to recreate the true IPA with this excellent and well named brew.

24 Carat Gold – Liverpool (500ml) 4.3% **3.55**

This beer is brewed with 100% brewer's gold hops giving a smooth luxurious ale with an orange citrus finish.

Liverpool Pale Ale – Liverpool (500ml) 4.1% **3.55**

This is a refreshing light ale with citrus overtones and a delicately hoppy taste before a lengthy bitter finish.

Kitty Wilkinson Chocolate & Vanilla Stout – Liverpool (500ml) 4.6% **3.65**

Part of Liverpool Organics 'Heroes of Liverpool' range this is a very deep dark brew with distinct chocolate and vanilla flavours.

Only down the road, Cains has been providing Liverpool with fine beers for over 150 years.

Cains Finest – Liverpool (500ml) 5% **3.60**

Liverpool's Finest home grown beer acknowledged by GQ magazine as the best beer in the world. Brewed using the finest 'Marris Otter' barley malt, then matured for 3 months to give it its unique rich aroma and full flavour.

Cains Fine Raisin Beer – Liverpool (500ml) 5% **3.60**

This award winning amber ale is infused with succulent Californian raisins it tastes great with cheese, meat or game.

Cains Formidable Ale (FA) – Liverpool (500ml) 5% **3.60**

Wapping Stout – Liverpool (500ml) 5% 3.45

One of Wappings seasonal beers this classic style stout has won acclaim with the bronze award at the 2010 Champion Winter Beers of Britain awards. This is stout as it should be, dark, bitter - sweet and with some mocha and liquorice flavours before a dry finish.

Lindemans' Framboise - Belgium (250ml) 2.5% 4.25

Brewed in a Lambic style, this oak aged fruit beer has raspberries added for a zingy and fresh taste. Great paired with one of our desserts like the roulade or trifle.

Lindemans' Kreik - Belgium (375ml) 3.5% 3.95

This traditional Lambic based beer is aged in oak barrels for up to 2 years with selected cherries being added to give fresh and fruity taste. Lovely paired with dessert like our cheesecake!

Lindemans' Pecheresse - Belgium (250ml) 2.5% 4.25

Served in a gold rimmed flute this Lambic style beer uses wild yeasts during fermentation. Peaches are added afterwards to produce a light and sweet fruit beer. Great paired with one of our desserts.

Westons Organic Cider – Herefordshire (500ml) 6.5% 3.60

Wines

Vistamar Sauvignon Blanc – Chile 13.5%

3.40/175ml glass, 4.60/250ml, 13.35/bottle

An elegant straw colour with vibrant greenish tinges, the nose offers tantalising tropical fruit aromas with delicate hints of scented white flowers. The palate is clean zesty and refreshing with ripe citrus and tropical fruit flavours balanced by a streak of crisp acidity

Colli Vicentini Pinot Grigio – Italy 12%

3.55/175ml glass 4.85/250ml, 14.25/bottle

A typical fruity bouquet but surprisingly full-bodied. Floral fruit character on the palate with good structure and refreshing acidity.

Vistamar Merlot – Chile 13.5%

3.40/175ml glass, 4.65/250ml, 13.75/bottle

An inviting deep ruby-red in colour, this wine is packed full of ripe blackberry and plum aromas with delicate hints of spice and crushed black pepper. The palate is succulent, soft and fruity, beautifully balanced by velvet-textured tannins as the key to its charm.

Nuviana Tempranillo/Cabernet Sauvignon – Spain 13.5%

3.55/175ml glass, 4.65/250ml, 13.75/bottle

Bright ruby colour with aromas of ripe dark berry fruit with hints of spice. The smooth palate gives layers of ripe berry fruit, dark chocolate and a touch of sweet oak on the finish.

Septima Malbec – Argentina 14%

15.30/bottle

An easy drinking wine with toasted oak, vanilla and cherry on the nose. A simple palate of dark fruits with good acidity and soft tannins.

Discovery Beach White Zinfandel – USA 11%

3.40/175ml glass, 4.40/250ml, 13.75/bottle

A popular medium dry rose with strawberry and candyfloss flavours. A lovely summery wine!

Nuviana Rose – Spain 13.5%

13.45/bottle

A raspberry pink colour with aromas of, strawberries and cherries. A wine with structure and freshness with a nice lingering finish.
